

1. Initial orders:

Ontario Regulation 67/93....*Health Care and Residential Facilities*

Section 97 (2) (d)

“The employer shall put into effect measures for the use of engineering controls appropriate in the circumstances. In this case improved measures for the use of engineering controls with respect to the equipment used to deliver antineoplastic drugs, in the chemotherapy suite, to eliminate spills, to protect workers who may be exposed to antineoplastic agents.”

Occupational Health and Safety Act

Section 57 (4)

The employer shall submit to the Ministry of Labour a compliance plan specifying what the employer plans to do to comply with the order above and when the employer intends to achieve compliance.
