Ontario Regulation 67/93....*Health Care and Residential Facilities*

1. Section 9 (1)

Pursuant to Section 9 (1) of O. Reg. 67/93, the employer shall develop establish and put into effect measures and procedures to control the exposure of a worker to cauterizing fumes in all facilities under control of the employer.

Occupational Health and Safety Act

2. Section 57 (4)

Pursuant to Section 57 (4) of the *Occupational Health and Safety Act*, the employer shall submit a compliance plan which sets out how and in what manner the employer intends to comply with order #1.

In complying with the above noted order the employer shall consider but shall not be limited to:

1. Toxic gaseous products
2. Smoke
3. Bioaerosols
4. Noise
5. Viruses or viable cellular material
6. Other airborne contaminants
7. P.P.E. and respirators
8. Ventilation – smoke evacuation or dedicated exhaust systems
