The vulnerable residents of Ontario's for-profit nursing homes need **safe, timely and appropriate care**. Yet every day, understaffing and unequal wages create conditions that don't allow nurses and health-care professionals to provide the care they know residents need. This is driving more staff away.

For-profit nursing homes corporations put profit over care, leading to dangerous conditions for residents and staff.

These corporations make record profits, like Extendicare, which made \$1.3 billion in 2023 alone. Meanwhile, their residents have a lower standard of living and their staff earn lower wages than nurses in hospitals.

Front-line nurses, personal support workers and guest attendants are fighting for care, not profit. They are negotiating a new contract with their employers that includes **staffing ratios and equal wages**.
