The reason for this visit was to assess compliance with the OHSA and applicable regulations.

Inspector Findings:

Internal Responsibility System (IRS) Assessment:

- -There are approximately 9000 workers at this workplace. This employer has contracted elements of it's operations to Ellis Don and Sodexo.
- -Good knowledge of roles and responsibilities exists amongst the workplace parties.
- -All workers and supervisors have completed Health and Safety Basic Awareness Training.
- -There is an active Joint Health and Safety Committee (JHSC) in the workplace consisting of 12 members from a variety of departments.
- -The JHSC meets on a monthly basis.
- -Greater than half of the JHSC is comprised of worker members.
- -11 members of the committee JHSC certified.
- -Discussed involvement of Ellis Don and Sodexo JHSC's in Brampton Civic Hospital JHSC meetings.
- -Monthly inspections of part of the workplace are conducted by JHSC members. The entirety of the workplace is inspected annually. Inspection results are available for review.

- -This employer has a Health and Safety, Workplace Violence and Workplace Harassment Policy/Program that have been reviewed within the last calendar year.
- -Discussed occupational health and safety orientation training and review with workplace parties. Workplace parties stated that online and in-person orientation training is conducted at a corporate and departmental level, and annual review is required.

Physical Inspection:

- -Observed screening stations at workplace entrances. This employer requires active screening for workers and visitors prior to entry.
- -Observed a damaged counter top in the N.6.054 room ORDER ISSUED.
- -Observed a clogged and leaking sink in the N.6.043 room ORDER ISSUED.
- -Discussed the use of slings for ceiling lifts with workplace parties, The employer indicated that slings are not always placed on beds due to supply shortage. This inspector will return at a later date with a MLITSD Ergonomist to further assess the use of slings on patient beds.
- -Observed damage to the door in the N.6.041 room ORDER ISSUED.
- -Observed several personal effects rooms with footwear placed on the floor in an unorganized manner. Discussed alternative methods of storage with workplace parties. Workplace parties agreed to ensure that footwear in personal effects rooms would not present a hazard of tripping/falling to workers.
- -Observed a half empty eyewash bottle present in the N.6.133 room ORDER ISSUED. The employer agreed to ensure than an eyewash fountain capable of providing several minutes of continuous flow was installed in the N.6.133 room.
- -Observed computer cables on the floor of the N.6.079 room stored in a manner that presented a hazard of tripping/falling to workers ORDER ISSUED.
- -Observed physio supplies and boxes in the N.6.079 room stored in a manner that presented a hazard to workers. ORDER ISSUED.
- -Observed a shelving unit in the N.6.422 room that was at risk of tipping/falling. ORDER ISSUED. The employer agreed to ensure that this unit is secured against tipping/falling before items are stored on this shelf.
- -Observed materials in the N.6.002 room stored in a manner that presented a hazard to workers, ORDER ISSUED.
- -Workplace parties stated that at the time of the inspection the refrigerator in the N.6.751 room was not functioning. ORDER ISSUED.
- -Observed a shelving unit in the N.6.752 room that was not secured against tipping/falling. ORDER ISSUED. The employer agreed to ensure that this unit is secured against tipping/falling before items are stored on this shelf.
