

**Ontario Nurses’
Association
General Contest Rules**

1. **Application.** These general contest rules (the “**General Contest Rules**”) apply to the ONA Census Contest (the “**Contest**”) operated by the Ontario Nurses’ Association. By entering the Contest, entrants (members) agree to be legally bound by these General Contest Rules, and will be deemed to have read and understood these General Contest Rules.

2. **Eligibility.** Unless otherwise stated, to enter the Contest and to be eligible to win, entrants (member) must be a member of the Ontario Nurses’ Association. Each entrant (member) must be over the age of majority in his/her province or territory of residence. Employees of the Ontario Nurses’ Association, its agents, prize sponsors, promotional and advertising agencies or of any other entity involved in the development, production, administration, or fulfillment of the applicable Contest, as well as the parents, siblings and children of any such employees and any person domiciled with such employees, are ineligible to enter.
 - (1) **Prizing & Contest Period.** A total of 100 \$100 cash prizes will be awarded through a random draw. Seventy-five of the \$100 cash prizes will be awarded around May 25, 2020. The remaining twenty-five of the \$100 cash prizes will be awarded December 18, 2020. The details of the prize(s) available to be won (including the number and the approximate retail value of the prize(s) available to be won), the duration and timing of a Contest and any other relevant information of the Contest will be identified through applicable promotional materials and by the ONA website at the start (or before the start) of the Contest. Prize(s) may not be exactly as advertised. Prize(s) must be accepted as awarded, may not be sold or transferred. Limit of one prize per household.

3. **Contest Entry.** No purchase necessary to enter the Contest. Unless otherwise stated, there is a limit of one (1) entry per entrant (member). To enter the Contest, entrants (members) must submit an update to their contact information via the online form at ona.org/census, or by calling ONA Dues and Membership intake a 1-800-387-5580, ext. 2200, or email updated information to memberchanges@ona.org. Instructions will also be provided on the Ontario Nurses’ Association website.

For call-in entry: Without limiting the foregoing, if entry in the Contest occurs via calling-in, call-in using the telephone number provided. If you are such caller, you may be deemed a potential winner and you may also be required to follow the instructions of the Ontario Nurses’ Association representative to validate your eligibility (e.g. identify your membership number and update your contact information).

For online entry: Without limiting the foregoing, if entry in a Contest occurs online, visit the Ontario Nurses’ Association website during the Contest entry period and follow the on-screen instructions on the ONA’s webpage to complete and submit the online membership information update form.

All entries are subject to verification at any time and for any reason. The Ontario Nurses’ Association reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to require proof of identity and/or eligibility (in a form acceptable to the Ontario Nurses’ Association – including, without limitation, government issued photo identification): (i) for the purposes of verifying a member’s eligibility to participate in the Contest; (ii) for the purposes of verifying the eligibility and/or legitimacy of any entry or other information entered (or purportedly entered) for the purposes of the Contest; and/or (iii) for any other reason the Ontario Nurses’ Association deems necessary, in its sole and absolute discretion, for the purposes of administering the Contest in accordance with the General Contest Rules and, if provided, any further Contest-related instructions. Failure to provide such proof to the complete satisfaction of the Ontario Nurses’ Association within the timeline specified by the Ontario Nurses’ Association may result in disqualification in the sole and absolute discretion of the Ontario Nurses’ Association.

4. **Prize Draw**. The ONA Census Contest winners will be selected from entries received. A random draw for the prize(s) will take place by an Ontario Nurses' Association representative from all eligible entries received during the Contest period. The potential prize winners will be contacted using the information provided at the time of entry. In the event a potential prize winner cannot be contacted within five (5) business days after the draw, as determined by Ontario Nurses' Association at its sole discretion, or if these General Contest Rules are not adhered to by a potential prize winner, such potential prize winner will be disqualified and will forfeit all rights to the applicable prize.
5. **Awarding of Prize(s)**. Proof of identification must be provided upon request. In order to be declared a prize winner, each potential winner must first: (i) correctly answer, unaided, a time limited mathematical skill testing question administered by the Ontario Nurses' Association; (ii) be verified as complying with these General Contest Rules (as determined by the Ontario Nurses' Association in its sole and absolute discretion); and (iii) accepts the applicable prize as offered and releases the Ontario Nurses' Association from any and all liability of any kind relating to the Contest and his/her receipt and use or misuse of the applicable prize.
6. **Odds of Winning**. The odds of winning will depend on the number of eligible entries received during the Contest period.
7. All decisions of the Ontario Nurse' Association with respect to any aspect of a Contest are final and binding on all entrants without right of appeal. The Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. ANY ENTRANT DEEMED BY THE ONTARIO NURSES' ASSOCIATION TO BE IN VIOLATION OF THESE GENERAL CONTEST RULES FOR ANY REASON IS SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION IN THE SOLE AND ABSOLUTE DISCRETION OF THE ONTARIO NURSES' ASSOCIATION AT ANY TIME.
8. By entering the Contest, each entrant (member) fully releases the Ontario Nurses' Association, Locals, prize suppliers, advertising/promotion agencies and any other entity involved in the development, production, administration, or fulfillment of the applicable Contest from all liability of any kind relating to the Contest or his/her participation therein, including, without limitation, any liability related to: (i) any failure of the a website; (ii) any technical malfunction or other problems of any nature whatsoever, including, without limitation, those relating to the telephone network or lines, computer on-line systems, servers, access providers, computer equipment or software; (iii) the failure of any entry or other information to be received, captured or recorded for any reason whatsoever, including, but not limited to, technical problems or traffic congestion on the internet or at any website; (iv) any injury or damage to an entrant's or any other person's computer or other device related to or resulting from participating in the Contest; and/or (v) any combination of the above.
9. ONA reserves the right to cancel, modify or suspend the Contest or to amend these General Contest Rules at any time and in any way, without prior notice, for any reason whatsoever. Without limiting the foregoing, if for any reason, in the opinion of ONA in its sole and absolute discretion, the Contest is not capable of running as originally planned, for example as a result of tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, mechanical manipulation or any other causes beyond its control, including any automated, macro, script, robotic or other system(s) or programs to enter, ONA reserves its right to amend, cancel or suspend the Contest and/or conduct a random draw from all previously received eligible entries. Without limiting the generality of the forgoing, ONA reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to administer an alternate test of skill as it deems appropriate based on the circumstances and/or to comply with applicable law.
10. If it is discovered by ONA (using any evidence or other information made available to or otherwise discovered by ONA) that any person has attempted to: (i) exceed any of the limits stated in these Rules; and/or (ii) use multiple names, identities, social media accounts, telephone numbers, email addresses and/or any automated, macro, script, robotic or other system(s) or program(s) to enter or otherwise participate in or to disrupt this Contest; then he/she may be disqualified from the Contest in the sole and absolute discretion of ONA.

11. By entering the Contest, each entrant (member) consents to the collection, use and distribution of his/her personal information (information that identifies an entrant as an individual, such as home telephone number, age and home address) by ONA for the purposes of implementing, administering and fulfilling the applicable Contest and in accordance with ONA's privacy policy, available at <http://www.ona.org/privacy-policy>. Any inquiry concerning the personal information held by ONA should be addressed to Privacy Officer at ona.org. This section does not limit any other consent(s) that an individual may provide ONA or others in relation to the collection, use and/or disclosure of their personal information.
