An Introduction to the Joint Health and Safety Committee

Date & Time: Tuesday, November 27, 2018, 16:30 to 18:00 EST (Eastern Standard Time).

Topic: Join us for this 90-minute session on Joint Health and Safety Committees (JHSCs). This webinar is designed for newer Health and Safety activists and representatives who want to learn more about health and safety. This presentation will include a high level overview of the JHSC, in particular its role, responsibilities and administrative processes.

Audience: This session will be of particular interest to New Leaders and JHSC members new to their role.

Format: Once again ONA's Regional Vice-President Laurie Brown, RN will be the moderator for this webinar. This session will be facilitated by Pat Caldwell, a member of ONA's own Membership Events and Education Team.

Following the presentation there will be an interactive question-and-answer session.

For members who do not have access to internet, a telephone number needed to call in, as well as the access code to enter will be provided.

When registering for the webinar, members will also be able to pre-submit any questions they would like addressed during the presentation.
