ONA Provincial Professional Practice Teleconnect RN and RPN Practice, the CNO Three Factor Framework and Nursing Assignments

Topic **RN and RPN Practice, the CNO Three Factor Framework and Nursing Assignments**

During this session, ONA's Professional Practice Specialists will discuss the three factors – the client, the nurse and the environment – that impact on decision-making related to care-provider assignment. We will outline professional expectations as they relate to the CNO Practice Standards and Guidelines and the scope of practice for RNs and RPNs, and we will clarify what factors should be considered when reviewing nursing assignments. We will provide examples of collaboration scenarios between the RN and RPN and highlight a few of ONA's recent settlements.

Participants are encouraged to send examples of brief scenarios, noting the client's acuity and the staffing, for possible use for discussion in the presentation. Deadline to submit your scenarios is noon on Friday, March 3, 2017.

Audience: This teleconnect will be of interest to ONA members, Unit reps, Professional Responsibility Complaint (PRC) reps, Bargaining Unit Presidents and Local Coordinators.

Format: ONA First Vice-President Vicki McKenna, RN, will be the moderator for this teleconference. It will begin with a short presentation by Professional Practice Specialists, followed by an interactive question-and-answer session after the presentation.
